Our aim is to provide an public access Emergency AFD defibrillator located on the gable end of the clubhouse exterior in a code locked public access safety box.

Due to the the recent incident during the Euro football championships where a player suffered a sudden cardiac arrest/event it was apparent that as a community club utilised by all age groups within a rurally isolated environment that covers the Southdown area and boat yards that are home to many residents of the village we feel that this life saving equipment is another vital addition to providing those possible additional seconds required to potentially save someone's life.

Our plan is to take complete ownership and management of the device from installation to maintenance so that our community has that chance if ever required to help sustain somebody until the ambulance service arrives as every second counts.
