Project Replacement Mat for Short Mat Bowls

Short Mat Bowls is played on a large mat 45ft x 6ft with a foam backing to it.

The one we currently use is the original we bought in 1994 and it's now beginning to show it's age.

The foam backing is now perished after 27 years use and disintegrating. Consequently after we have used it there is a lot of perished foam left on the hall floor. We obviously clean it up but any inadvertently left behind could be a hazard to the Pre school children the following morning.

In addition the mat is not level any more due to the foam missing in areas of it therefore that affects the accuracy of our game of bowls.

We would be grateful if the Parish Council could look favourably at out grant request to replace the mat.

We have researched replacement mats and had some samples sent to us. Although some are cheaper than the one we have chosen they are of inferior quality and will not last very long as we need a mat that is flexible to roll onto the frame for storage.
