Describe the overall aim of your organisation and the activities or services it provides.

Our organisation main aim is to support ST Columba & Torpoint RFC in providing safe rugby, rugby training and rugby facilities within SE Cornwall area. This is done across a 3 Sections within the rugby club, Mens XV Rugby, Youth Rugby and Touch Mixed Rugby. The rugby club has an age range of players from 5 to 55.
