As some of you may already know, I have recently been forced to close my small business due to no fault of my own.

This has been devastating, not only for me, but also for the local small businesses I supported by selling their goods, ie Cornish Pod, Caked in it & Baxters bathbombs, along with local crafters.

There has been an unbelievable amount of local support, both emotionally and financially, for example, when I arrived at the horsebox a couple of days ago, there had been an envelope left, no name, just "with love" written on it, containing £200, also within the first day of closing, donations amounting to a staggering £250 were donated to help restart.
