



## Millbrook Skatepark Project Raffle

On 16<sup>th</sup> February Mr Aaron Barrett attended the Parish Council with a vision of creating a new concrete skate park.

Prior to this the Parish Council had received some complaints over noise issues from the ramps. Aaron highlighted that the current ramps are hollow, concrete is solid and therefore quieter.

Aaron said he would like to work with the Council to put together a few ideas. A Facebook forum page was set up and a WhatsApp group created, which includes Cllr Matthew Beadnall, Aaron Barrett, Sol Smith & Andrew Mitchell,

CC Kate Ewert and Millbrook Parish Clerk Karenza Heald.

So far over 20 local businesses have supported the project by funds, raffle prizes and selling raffle tickets.

To achieve funding for a new concrete skatepark, similar to the designs on the group Facebook page and shown in the Rame Centre window, the project needs to be community driven with a proactive committee actively fundraising.
