

Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984)

The County of Cornwall (Millpool Head and King Street, Millbrook) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2022

- 1. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by traffic over an area of highway being Millpool Head between the junction of King Street and property named the Devon & Cornwall Hotel and King Street between property number 6 and the junction of Millpool Head, Millbrook as highlighted in red on the plan attached to this Order.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on 9th January 2023 and shall remain in force for eighteen months, however, this order can be extended by the Secretary of State for Transport. The works are expected to be completed by the 13th January 2023.
- 3. The prohibition will be in force between the hours of 0800 and 2000, weekdays only.
- 4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this Order "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 5. The Council is satisfied that the prohibition is needed because ducting works are being executed on or near the road.
- 6. While the Order is in operation traffic, including bicycle movement, along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of highway described above.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

Any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitate the bringing of vehicles into the section of highway to which this order applies.

Traffic associated with the works required within the highway specified above.

An alternative route will be available for use while the Order is in force being Knill Cross, Higher Anderton Road, Lower Anderton Road, B3247 Between Higher Lodge And The War Memorial, B3247 Between War Memorial And Junction Nne Of Fourlanesend Primary School, B3247 Between Hat Lane And Maker Lane, B3247 Between West Street And Hat Lane, Millpool Head.

Pedestrian and Vehicular access to residents and businesses will be maintained.
