Part 1: Thursday 19th January 2023 – Walkabout around Millbrook Village.



Bottom of Fore Street / junctions of King Street / West Street. See figs 6	Cllr E Woffenden, who was unable to attend the meeting, emailed to say the area at the bottom of West Street - between premier and the alleyway and the pub and pavement opposite is a seen as priority. Visibility of pedestrians and cyclists (many of whom are children) is very poor and vehicles drive thru there at ridiculously dangerous speeds.	All present in the meeting agreed it was difficult to find a solution. Possible suggestions 'shared space' / rumble strip / cyclists to officially be permitted to cycle 'down' West Street	
West Street	Parking along West Street A previous suggestion had been recommended for designated parking bays along West Street.	Cllr Ewert highlighted space would be lost and if a permit holder system was used this would cover anyone from 'PL10 1'	
Dodbrook See figs 7 & 8	Red anti walkway has faded. Quotation received in April 2021 from Cormac Highways Manager – A very rough costing for the anti skid (red) surfacing would be 8K.	Recommendation: Reinstate the white lining and the faded pedestrian signage.	
Tanyard (i) Millpool Head	Wheelchair / Push chair access issues. Railings not recommended by Highways. Bollards considered as an option.	JW suggested MPC signage on the wall.	
Tanyard (ii) Corner	Ongoing issue with cars parked on the corner. Issue has been reduced since the banner was fixed on the wall.	Top priority 'No loading'
