Historically, the event has been underwritten for insurance purposes by the Rame and Torpoint Lions, the Lions have then had bucket collections to raise money for themselves on the day. Unfortunately, there has been an issue discovered with their insurance provision which has meant that they can no longer provide insurance for these type of events. This is something that is not just affecting our event, but all Lions events across the Country. The Black Prince crew must now find funds to insure this event at fairly short notice, to cover the event fully we are expecting this to cost up to £750. In addition to this, we now have to provide portaloo's in Venton House for the Millbrook portion of the day, and first aid cover that was previously providing for free from St Johns Ambulance. These are sudden costs that we haven't had the opportunity to fund raise for this year.

#### Who will benefit from the project?

We estimate that around 500 people attend the Millbrook part of the event.

Residents and young people in Millbrook, through a fully inclusive community event, reinforcing our strong community feeling in the village.

Children that attend Millbrook school, taking part in the May Pole dancing, and a traditional folk/Cornish May day event.

Businesses such as shops, pubs and cafes in the village with an increase in business and trade
