Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicular Traffic Order 2023

1. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic over an area of highway being The Parade, New Street, King Street, Wells Court, Millbrook for their entire lengths, West Street, Millbrook between the junction of Wells Court and Fore Street, Fore Street, Millbrook between the junction of Kings Street and West Street, Millpool Head, Millbrook between the junction of Kings Street to grid reference SX4236351994. Road from Jackmans Meadow to Lower Row, Lower Row, The Green, Green Lane, Market Street, The Cleave, Kingsand for their entire lengths, Fore Street, Kingsand between the junction of Market Street to grid reference SX4341450507. Garrett Street, The Square, Road from the Square to Cawsand Beach, The Bound, Cawsand for their entire lengths, as highlighted in red on the plan attached to this Order
2. The Order shall come into operation at 09:30 on the 1st May 2023 and continue until the 17:00 on the 1st May 2023. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this Order "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. The Council is satisfied that the Order is needed to facilitate the holding of the following relevant event Black Prince Flower Boat Festival.
4. While the Order is in operation traffic, including bicycle movement, along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of road described above.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- a. Any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle, or any personnel on official duty, or any vehicle or person authorised by and with the permission of Cornwall Council.
- b. Any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitate the bringing of vehicles into the section of highway to which this order applies.
- c. Traffic associated with the event required within the highway specified in Paragraph 1.
