Dear Members,

Re: Kingfisher Pre-School – Contribution Request

I have been asked, by the Members of Maker with Rame Parish Council, to correspond with you in relation to the above detailed facility, which is utilized by a substantial number of Millbrook Parishioners.

As you may be aware, Kingfisher Pre School is located within the Maker with Rame Parish. Due to the excellent opportunities that the pre-school offers, a substantial number of Millbrook residents have opted to send their children to Kingfisher, notwithstanding the existence of a pre-school group within Millbrook Parish.

At present, there are 19 children registered for the new school year. Of this total number, 12 children (63%) reside in Millbrook.

The Pre-School recently experienced some financial difficulty and approached Maker with Rame Parish Council for assistance. The Parish Council was of the firm opinion that the pre-school was a valuable asset to the community and could, therefore, not be left to founder. It was agreed that the Council would assist Kingfisher, through the purchase of required, educational, supplies.

We feel sure that the Members of Millbrook Parish Council will appreciate that many of the consumable supplies will be utilized for the benefit and development of children who reside in Millbrook Parish and feel that it would be fair and equitable to seek a contribution towards the purchase costs of the said equipment, from Millbrook Parish Council.

To date, the sum of (net) £1,230 has been spent on equipment for the facility.

The Members of Maker with Rame Parish Council respectfully suggest that 50% of the total net sum expended might be provided by Millbrook Parish Council, in support of the children of its parishioners, who attend Kingfisher Pre-School.
