Describe the overall aim of your organisation and the activities or services it provides.

We are the committee that organise the annual Black Prince Flower Boat Festival that welcomes Spring and Summer each year with Morris dancing, school and community engagement and bringing visitors to our villages for the start of our summer season.

Project Details

Please outline the details of the project for which you are seeking funding from the Council

Each year we put on the Black Prince Flower Boat Festival, this community event fosters community engagement and involves children from the two schools that serve the parishes. Children from Fourlanesend Primary School take part in the traditional May Pole dance, the town crier competition and the fete that is put on at Kingsand Community Hall raises money for local charities and organisations. We aim to provide a day of community fun and togetherness, whilst raising money for local charities and highlighting the beautiful Rame Peninsula.

Historically, the Rame and Torpoint Lions provided us with insurance cover, but a change in their national office means that this is no longer possible (for all events they support). Due to the changing criteria for event insurance, we have had to seek 3rd party management for the traffic control to keep our event and community safe while still delivering this annual event for residents and visitors.

Who will benefit from the project?

This event benefits residents of all ages from across the community, from the local preschool to the primary school, the residents of Kingsand & Cawsand who decorate their homes and the businesses within the villages who enjoy increased custom.

Approximately how many of those who will benefit are parishioners?

We estimate that around 500 people attend the Millbrook part of the event. Residents and young people in Millbrook, through a fully inclusive community event, reinforcing our strong community feeling in the village. Children that attend Millbrook school, taking part in the May Pole dancing and a traditional folk/Cornish May day event. Businesses such as shops, pubs and cafes in the village with an increase in business and trade.
