**Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984)**

**The County of Cornwall (Maker Lane, Millbrook) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2026**

1. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by traffic over an area of highway being Maker Lane, Millbrook for its entire length as highlighted by the red dashed line on the plan attached to this Order.
2. The Order shall come into operation on 5th June 2026 and shall remain in force for eighteen months, however, this order can be extended by the Secretary of State for Transport. The works are expected to be completed by the 5th June 2026.
3. The prohibition will be in force between the hours of 0930 and 1530, weekdays only.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this Order "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
5. The Council is satisfied that the prohibition is needed because overhead cabling and pole testing works are being executed on or near the road.
6. While the Order is in operation traffic along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of highway described above.

**Nothing in the Order will apply to:**

Any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle, or any personnel on official duty, or any vehicle or person authorised by and with the permission of Cornwall Council.

Any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitate the bringing of vehicles into the section of highway to which this order applies.

Traffic associated with the works required within the highway specified above.

Cyclists.

An alternative route will be available for use while the Order is in force being Knill Cross, King Street, Millpool Head, B3247 Between West Street And Hat Lane, B3247 Between Hat Lane And Maker Lane.

Pedestrian and Vehicular access to residents and businesses will be maintained.
